First Aid/CPR/AED Certification Course

Program Summary

This course will provide individuals the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide basic care for injuries and sudden illnesses, including how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED) for victims of sudden cardiac arrest, until advanced medical personnel arrive and take over. Upon completion, students will receive a *Generations Southeast* certificate and *American Heart Association* certification valid for two (2) years. All courses are open to the public.
